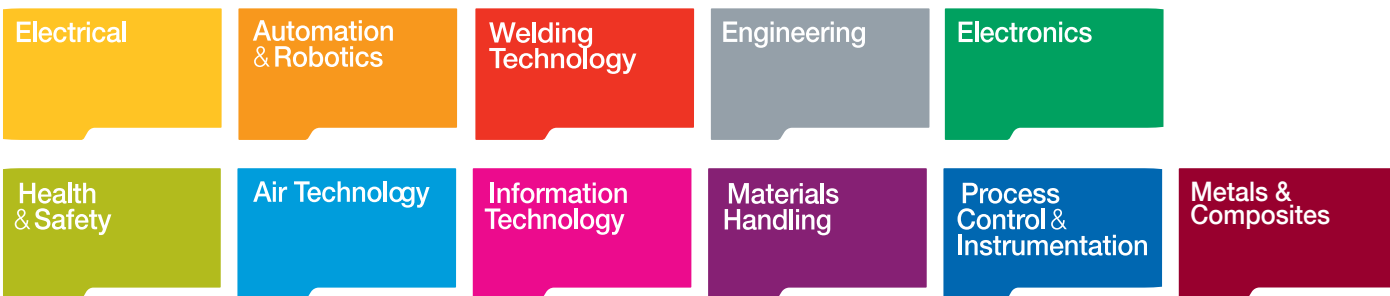

Key Statistics from NMW 2010

- There were 9,727 total visits over four days of NMW 2010.
- 82% of surveyed visitors, who had direct authority or influence to purchasing the types of goods on display, saw something at NMW 2010 that they were likely to buy after the exhibition.
